BIOGRAPHY

Nieves Rosell is an **Argentine singer, songwriter, and guitarist, based in São Paulo.** Her music is shaped by the encounter of different song traditions, revealing an identity built between **Latin America, jazz, and Brazilian music.**



Throughout her career, she has performed in **theaters, jazz clubs, festivals, hotels, and international cruises**, developing a versatile artistic presence for audiences from different cultures.

Her original music is developed through collaborations with Argentine and Brazilian musicians.

In 2024, in São Paulo, she released the **single Cassia**, featuring her original composition with lyrics by Adrián Abonizio, produced by Lisandro Massa and recorded alongside lury Batista and Carlos Bala.

That same year, in Buenos Aires, she recorded the **album Boleros**, featuring reinterpretations of classics from the genre, produced by Daniel Maza, with the special participation of Uruguayan guitarist Leonardo Amuedo.

Currently, she develops projects alongside musicians from São Paulo's jazz scene, exploring the dialogue between American standards, Brazilian songs, and Latin American boleros.

At the same time, she continues developing her original music in collaboration with Argentine and Brazilian musicians, coordinates the Voice and Artistic Development Laboratory, and works as a cultural producer.
